

Population of around 11 million






# Geographical Location

Baden-Wuerttemberg is located in the South West of Germany

# Pforzheim Golden City and Gateway to the Black Forest

- Industrial city at the northern edge of the black forest
- Inhabitants: 320.000 (City: 120.000, County: 200.000)
- Destroyed during World War II, reconstructed as a typical "modern" city
- Jewellery manufacturing since 1767 leading in jewellery & silver production (Chopard, Wellendorf, etc.)



## Semesterdates

Fall Semester	Spring Semester
starts last week of September, classes and exams end around beginning of February	starts the second week of March, classes and exams end mid of July
FAST TRACK: In case an exchange student will have to continue the study program at the home university in the beginning of January, students may get an extra examination before Christmas	

The voluntary pre-semester course "German as a Foreign Language" starts about 4 weeks before the classes.

Exchange students should arrive about three days before the beginning of the program.

#### Language requirements

ENGLISH: min. B2 level. Min. TOEFL (IBT > 85; CBT>235; ITP> 570) or any other official test like IELTS (min. 6.5), TOEIC, PTE, CPE etc.

GERMAN (for certain Double Degree programs or if you choose courses in German): min. B2 level, TESTDAF (> 16 and min. 4 in all parts), DSH 2 Examination, Goethe Certificate C2, or TEIC Deutsch C1 Hochschule)

#### Fees


Student service fee by the Deutsches Studierendenwerk. It is a contribution to run cafeterias, student halls etc. and covers free access to the public transportation system of the city.
