

BAE 3045 – International Management Skills

2 SWS (semester weekly hours), 3 credits

You should take this course directly after your internship / study semester abroad (“experience phase” outside HS PF), prior to your return to HS PF for your 6th/7th semester

Overview and course topic: You are enabled to develop your international management skills. **It is what you do, that you learn**

Learning Objectives

- Students are familiar with cross-cultural management (in engineering)
